### IF YOU ARE CONCERNED:

- If you see a learner in distress or a learner tells you something that means they may be at risk always report it
- Never promise confidentiality tell them you will have to pass it on
- Don't try to resolve concerns, report it to a member of staff who will contact our Safeguarding team, please leave your contact details, so our Safeguarding Officer can get in touch with you if needed

## We are committed to safeguarding our learners

#### We need you to support us by:

- Keeping to the boundaries of the purpose of your visit
- Being mindful of your own behaviours, particularly those that may put you at risk of an allegation being made against you
- Acting promptly if you are concerned about a learner
- Have your visitor ID on show at all times

- Sexual abuse
- Physical abuse
- Neglect
- Emotional abuse
- Bullying, harassment or discrimination
- Cyber bullying
- Financial abuse
- Radicalisation
